Paro-01, Thimpu-2

Day 1

Arrive Paro

The flight to Bhutan takes you over the great Himalayas, offering the most scintillating scenery of the world's highest glacial peaks. Upon your arrival representative from Wind Horse Tours & Treks will



receive you and transfer to Hotel through fascinating valley of Paro. Ta Dzong (national Museum), the best place to familiarize about Bhutanese religion, customs and traditional arts & crafts. Then walk down the trail to see Rinpung Dzong (the fortress of the heap of Jewels built in the 17th century), traditionally this is the office of district governor's and the living place for monks. Overnight in hotel.

Day2

Paro >>Thimphu

Morning hike to Taktsang Monastery, which takes about 15 minutes drive to the starting, point. The hike to Taktsang takes about an hour uphill till the viewpoint. Initially, Guru Rinpoche visited and meditated in 8th century at this particular site. The Desi Tenzin Rabgye later built the temple in the 17th century. Lunch at cafeteria. Afternoon visit ruined Drukgyel Dzong, the place of historic war between Tibet and Bhutan in 17th century. Stop at Kyichu Lhakhang, built in 7th century during the reign of first Tibetan king; Evening drive Thimphu. Overnight in hotel

Day 3

Thimphu

Morning sightseeing includes - Institute of traditional medicines, where they display all the indigenous raw materials used for preparing medicines; Folk and Heritage Museum, which displays day to day livelihood of typical Bhutanese farmers and their accessories; visit Painting School, which preserves our traditional paintings, sculpturing and wood curving; Late King's Memorial Stupa, built for the world peace; Traditional Handmade Paper Factory. National Handicraft Emporium, the best place to see varieties of products from Bhutan. Overnight in hotel
